** When the alleged or suspected abuse involves a person responsible for the care, custody, or welfare of the child, the report <u>must be made to DFPS</u>

Alleged abuse and/or neglect suspected -OR-

Sexual activity reported, patient is pregnant OR has confirmed STI

Age 17+

Patient must consent to report abuse to authorities

All clients shall receive "Notice to Victims of Family Violence"

(see Appendix 3)

Age 14, 15, 16

Affirmative Defense Established?

- Sex partner not more than 3 years older
- 2. <u>AND</u>, sex partner is of the opposite sex
- 3. **AND**, the sex partner did not use duress, force, or a threat against the victim at the time of the encounter

Must document Affirmative Defense using appropriate section of ROS in EHR.

Age 13 or younger

** Remember, there is NO affirmative defense for children under age of 14!

Yes

No report required

All reports to DFPS must be made within 48 hours of knowledge of alleged abuse and/or neglect.

- Employee filing report must complete Child Abuse Reporting Form (e-Cliniform)
- 2. Report to DFPS (see numbers above)
- 3. Place case number on Child Abuse Reporting Form, or print and scan online confirmation report.
