Treatment: Displays each Rx from Current Medications & Treatment with the Status of current medications, the Comments of Rx's added in the Treatment window, and the linked Assessment*. Displays the text of the Notes section of the Treatment window as "Patient Instructions".

Tests ordered/performed today: Displays the name and order date of "**Labs:**" and "**Imaging Studies and Other Tests:**"

Tests ordered for a future date: Displays the name and order date for future orders with linked Assessment*

We have referred you to the following doctors/clinics: Displays the provider to whom the patient is being referred, the reason(s), and the linked Assessment*

Your Next Appointment(s): Displays the date and time of upcoming scheduled appointments (does not display reason).

Recommended Wellness and Prevention Guidelines: Displays practice alerts applicable to this patient (i.e. A1c every 6 months)

You are Diagnosed with: Displays Assessment(s)' ICD-9 code(s) and description(s). (Text entered into the Notes section of the Assessment window is not displayed)

Immunizations given: Displays the name of the immunizations given today. (Text entered into the Comments section when adding immunizations is not displayed.)

Preventive Medicine: Displays all information entered into the Preventive Medicine window (including the name of the folder used, the name/prompt of the data fields, the data entered into the data fields, and the text entered into the notes section).

*An assessment's description will display in parenthesis next to individual Rx's, Tests, and Referrals with which the assessment is associated if the "Show associated assessments" box is checked. "For Others" will display for any Rx's, Tests, or Referrals not associated with any assessment.

The Problem List & Allergies are included on the Visit Summary as part of the Continuity of Care Document.
